Aim of the competition

Developing marksmanship skills, Promotion of shooting sports, Integration of the shooting society.

Requirements for participation

All sport shooters holding a valid Sport Shooter's License of the Polish Association of Sport Shooting. Others can participate but will not be classified in the bulletin of the Polish Association of Sport Shooting (*this is only required for holders of the license to prolong it, you can still participate and win prizes without a license*).

Disciplines

Six different disciplines will be shot during the competition.

Disciplines list

1. SP25 - Sport pistol (rimfire) - distance 25m, 13 shots – 10 best hits count, time no more than 5 minutes. Target – Target (NT 23p) Soldier's Torso,

2. CP25 - Centerfire pistol - distance 25m, 13 shots – 10 best hits count, time no more than 5 minutes. Target – Target (NT 23p) Soldier's Torso,

3. CP50 - Centerfire pistol with a buttstock (Submachinegun-like) - distance 50m, 13 shots – 10 best hits count, time no more than 5 minutes. Target – Target (NT 23p) Soldier's Torso, allowed are only pistol caliber firearms with a buttstock such as PM-84P Glauberyt, UZI SMG, Vz.61 Scorpion, MP-5, PM-63 RAK, etc. no optical sights on the firearm or observation optics are allowed. Standing shooting stance.

4. SR50 - Sport rifle (rimfire) - distance 50m, 13 shots – 10 best hits count, time no more than 5 minutes. Target – Target (NT 23p) Soldier's Torso, no optical sights on the firearm or observation optics are allowed. Standing shooting stance.

5. CR50 - Centerfire rifle - distance 50m, 13 shots – 10 best hits count, time no more than 5 minutes. Target – Target (NT 23p) Soldier's Torso, no optical sights on the firearm or observation optics are allowed. Standing shooting stance.

6. Smoothbore shotgun 2x5 – distance 10m from the fire line, 10 shots, Target – 10 metal popper targets. Each hit counts as 10 points. Each miss constitutes an additional minus 10 points penalty. The final score is called a FACTOR, which is a sum of all the points and penalties divided by the overall time (in seconds) from the initiation buzz until the final shot taken. The person with the highest FACTOR wins. Weapon – smoothbore pump action shotgun.

Weapons and ammunition

The organizer provides the following weapons in the following calibers:

Centerfire pistol and pistol with buttstock in 9mm Parabellum, Sport pistol and rifle (rimfire) in .22LR, Centerfire Rifle in .223Rem, Smoothbore shotgun in 12GA (12/70)

The organizer provides the weapons and ammunition with prior arrangement and payment of the applicable ammunition fee.

Classification

Participants will be classified individually in each discipline separately as well as in a general classification of the competition.

For the general classification of the competition a sum of all the scores of every discipline that the shooter took part in is taken into account.

As for the Smoothbore shotgun 2x5 discipline the general classification score will be calculated according to the equation: FACTOR x 20 = amount of points for the general classification.





Awards

Places 1 through 3 in the Individual and General classifications will be awarded Diplomas.

Additionally the **1st place in the General classification** will be promoted with a prize of: an **Arex REX 9mm Parabellum Pistol** which is the newest firearm of the **Polish Police** sponsored by Stowarzyszenie Zbrojownia.

The competition will take place regardless of weather conditions.

Final notes

Awards will be issued on the day of the event. If the winner is not present during the award ceremony the awards should be picked up within 7 days after the event. Awards that have not been picked up in this time will be added to the pool of award for the subsequent shooting competition.

In regards to the Arex REX 9mm Parabellum Pistol award, if for formal reasons the firearm will not be picked up within 7 days after the event, it will be stored at the Son of Gun firearms dealer in Suchy Las, Poland until it will be possible for the winner to pick up the award.

The Organizer reserved the right to close the registration of new contestants because of a limited amount of free slots.

The competition will the carried out according the hereby Statute and laws and regulations of the Polish Association of Sport Shooting. The competition is a part of the yearly roster of competitions of the Greater Poland Association of Sport Shooting and accredited by the Greater Poland College of Sport Shooting Jurors.
